I, DAVID C. WRIGHT, declare and state as follows:

- 1. I am an attorney licensed to practice law before all of the courts of the State of California and I am a partner with the law firm of McCune Wright Arevalo, LLP, counsel of record for Plaintiff NGL Transportation, LLC, ("Plaintiff"). The following facts are within my personal knowledge or based on records and files at my law firm, and, if called upon as a witness, I could and would testify competently thereto.
- 2. As Class Counsel, I was authorized and directed to perform all settlement administration duties set out in the Settlement Agreement, including providing Notice to the class members and establishing, maintaining, and administering a website dedicated to the Settlement which will provide information about the Settlement, including all relevant documents, pursuant to the Court's Order Granting Preliminary Approval of Class Settlement (Order"), dated October 2, 2020. (Dkt No. 223.)

SETTLEMENT NOTICE PROGRAM

3. The elements of the Notice Program included Notice via email, Notice via U.S. Mail, and a dedicated website on which the Notice has been posted.

Notice to the Class

- 4. Class Counsel identified 434 Class Members based upon the per diem charge data provided by Defendant, as analyzed by Plaintiffs' expert, Arthur Olsen.
- 5. Of the 434 Class Members, Class Counsel was able to identify current email addresses for 302 class members. On February 24, 2021, Class Counsel emailed Notice to those 302 Class Members. Of these, Class Counsel was unable to deliver a total of 77 Notices. Of these, a total of 20 Notices sent by email could not be delivered to Class Members because the email address no longer existed, the email account was closed, or the email address had a bad domain name or address error (collectively, "Hard Bouncebacks"). The remaining 57 Notices sent by email could not be delivered to Class Members due to an inactive or disabled account, the recipient's mailbox was full, technical auto-replies, or the recipient server was busy or unable to deliver (collectively,

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"Soft Bouncebacks"). For the 77 Class Members for whom email bouncebacks were received, supplemental notice was effected using First Class U.S. Mail.

For the remaining 132 class members for whom Class Counsel could not 6. identify current email addresses, Class Counsel identified the mailing/physical address for each class member through online public source information. On February 24, 2021, Class Counsel sent notice to these 132 Class Members via First Class United States Mail. Of these mailed notices, 33 were returned by the U.S. Post Office as undeliverable. Searches utilizing the California Secretary of State business search portal and, where necessary, the Secretary of State business search portal of the foreign state corresponding to the mailing address of the class members, were conducted for these 33 class members. Of these, 20 of the Class Members were determined to no longer be going concerns based on the following status listed in the Secretary of State records: Withdrawn (1); Suspended (10); Dissolved (6); Forfeited (1); Inactive (1); and Surrender (1). No record could be located for 7 of the Class Members. Five of these class members were determined to be going concerns with mailing address information that was at variance with the mailing address used for the notice. Supplemental notice is being provided to these class members. One class member was listed as "Active" but the mailing address on file with the California Secretary of State was the same address to which the original Notice had been mailed.

Website

Pursuant to Section 5(d) of the Order, on February 24, 2021, Class Counsel 7. launched the Settlement Website, https://mccunewright.com/mol-america-intermodalcontainer-per-diem-class-settlement/, containing detailed information about the Settlement. The Settlement Website address was included in the Notice sent to Class Members. The Notice, along with other relevant documents, was posted on the Settlement Website, so that potential claimants may review and download them. The Settlement Website also includes relevant dates and other Settlement-related information

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8. Class Counsel has maintained and will continue to maintain and update the Settlement Website throughout the Settlement administration as required by the Agreement or as directed by the Parties.

OBJECTIONS AND OPT OUTS

- 9. Pursuant to the Court's Order Granting Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement, (Dkt. No. 223) and the Court's Order Granting Joint Stipulation to Continue the Hearing on Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement, (Dkt. No. 227), Class Members wishing to be excluded from the Settlement were required to submit written requests for exclusion to the Claims Administrator, postmarked no later than March 26, 2021.
- 10. As of March 26, 2021, Class Counsel had not received any requests for exclusion. As of April 14, 2021, Class Counsel has not received any delinquent requests for exclusion.
- 11. Pursuant to the Court's Order Granting Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement, (Dkt. No. 223) and the Court's Order Granting Joint Stipulation to Continue the Hearing on Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement, (Dkt. No. 227), Class Members wishing to object to the fairness, reasonableness, or adequacy of the Agreement have the option to submit written objections to the Claims Administrator, emailed or postmarked no later than March 26, 2021.
- 12. As of March 26, 2021, Class Counsel had not received any objections. As of April 14, 2021, Class Counsel has not received any delinquent objections.
